

AGREEMENT FOR COLLECTION OF SUMMER SCHOOL PROPERTY TAXES

AGREEMENT made this (Day of Month) day of (Month), (Year) by and between the (Intermediate School District), with offices located at above address (herein-after "School District") and (Township) Township with offices located at (Street Address), (City, State, Zip Code). (hereinafter "Township/City"), pursuant to 1976 PA 451, as amended, for the purposes of providing for the collection by township/city of a summer levy of (Number of Mills) mills of school district property taxes for the year (Year).

The parties agree as follows: [estimated cost: _____\$_____]

1. The township/city agrees to collect (Number of Mills) mills of the total school property taxes as certified by the school district levy on July 1 on property located within the township/city.
2. The school district agrees to pay township/city costs of assessment and collection as follows:
 - a. reasonable expenses in accordance with PA 333, Sections 1611 and 1612, and in accordance with PA 503.
 - b. the collecting township/city agrees to furnish verification of expenses upon request of the school district.
3. No later than June 15, the school district shall certify to the township supervisor the school millage to be levied on property for summer collection in 2006. (The board adopted their resolution in May and is included.)
4. The township/city treasurer shall account for and deliver summer school tax collections according to the following schedule: within ten (10) business days after the first (1st) and fifteenth (15th) day of each month, with final adjustment to be made on or before April 1.
