

Sexual Offender Registry Act of 1994

(e) “**Listed offense**” means any of the following:

(i) A violation of section 145a, 145b, or 145c of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.145a, 750.145b, and 750.145c [**accosting or soliciting a minor for immoral purposes**].

(ii) A violation of section 158 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.158, if a victim is an individual less than 18 years of age [**re: sodomy < 18**].

(iii) A third or subsequent violation of any combination of the following:

(A) Section 167(1)(f) of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.167 [**indecent or obscene conduct**].

(B) Section 335a of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.335a [**indecent exposure**].

(C) A **local ordinance** of a municipality substantially corresponding to a section described in sub-subparagraph (A) or (B).

(iv) **Except for a juvenile disposition or adjudication**, a violation of section 338, 338a, or 338b of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.338, 750.338a, and 750.338b, if a victim is an individual **less than 18** years of age [**gross indecency between females, males or females & males**].

(v) A violation of section 349 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.349, if a victim is an individual less than 18 years of age [**kidnapping <14**].

(vi) A violation of section 350 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.350 [**taking / holding hostage**].

(vii) A violation of section 448 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.448, if a victim is an individual less than 18 years of age [**accosting or soliciting for / to prostitution**].

(viii) A violation of section 455 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.455 [**pandering / prostitution**].

(ix) A violation of section 520b, 520c, 520d, 520e, or 520g of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520b, 750.520c, 750.520d, 750.520e, and 750.520g [**sexual offenses w/ minor: 1st degree: penetration < age 13, 2nd degree: contact < 13, 3rd degree: penetration >13, <16, 4th degree: contact >13, < 16 or assault w/ intent to commit sexual conduct**].

(x) **Any other violation** of a law of this state or a local ordinance of a municipality that **by its nature constitutes a sexual offense** against an individual who is less than 18 years of age.

(xi) An **offense committed by a person** who was, at the time of the offense, a **sexually delinquent person** as defined in section 10a of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.10a.

(xii) An attempt or conspiracy to commit an offense described in subparagraphs *(i)* to *(xi)*.

(xiii) An offense substantially similar to an offense described in subparagraphs *(i)* to *(xii)* under a law of the United States, any state, or any country or under tribal or military law.

These listed offenses also include such crimes as:

- ◆ Child sexually abusive activity or material;
- ◆ Third or subsequent violation of any combination of disorderly person, neglect to support a family, or cohabitation by unmarried men and women;
- ◆ Any similar ordinances, state laws, and laws of other countries, tribes and military law.
