Pursuant to the Management and Budget Act, the May Consensus Revenue Estimating Conference will be held on Friday, May 20, 2022.

The principals of the Consensus Revenue Estimating Conference have determined that the conference will be held in-person in the House Appropriations Committee Room on the third floor of the Michigan State Capitol. The conference will begin at 9 a.m. with presentations focusing on the U.S. and Michigan economies and state government revenues.

Official revenue forecasts for fiscal years 2022, 2023, and 2024 will be revised by a consensus of the conference principals, consisting of the State Treasurer, the Director of the Senate Fiscal Agency, and the Director of the House Fiscal Agency.
