RE: Consensus Revenue Estimating Conference — January 12, 2024

A Consensus Revenue Estimating Conference will convene at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, January 12, 2024, in the House Appropriations Committee Room (Room 352) on the third floor of the Capitol.

At this conference, economists from the House Fiscal Agency, Senate Fiscal Agency, and Department of Treasury will present their economic and revenue forecasts for FY 2023-24, FY 2024-25, and FY 2025-26.
