Transportation Network Company

When an LEA is hiring a third-party vendor to transport students, not using a school bus, there are requirements and laws that must be satisfied relating to your decision. The requirements are for both the company and the LEA in the form of documentation. <u>The LEA is responsible to collect and file all of the information from the company employed including</u>:

- 7. Dispatch communication with parent & school
 - a. LEA Transportation Supervisor must be included in communication,
 - b. Call procedure established in the event of emergency, weather, early dismissal.

IV. The LEA will PERFORM for the District & Transportation Network Company

- 1. Driver fingerprinting,
- 2. Driver criminal background checks,
- 3. Corporal punishment policy
- 4. Restraint & Seclusion policy
- 5. MDE / PTAC Advisory vehicle capacity
- **6.** Include the LEA Transportation Department in communications network.

Laws relating to each section of the law

*Section 380.1230a Revised School Code Act 451 of 1976. The school is required to perform fingerprinting and the criminal background check.

School District - Governing body responsible to conduct fingerprinting and criminal background checks

Corporal punishment
