2. [Presentation - Scott Hutchins, MDE - Section 31 grants](#)
 - a. Discussion and several concerns/questions raised about 31p/Trails
Section 31aa - \$109/student equivalent if all applied - not all did - allocations will increase. 612 LEA's applied.
Section 97 - School Safety
Section 97b - SRO match
3. [Approval of October minutes](#) - Linda made the motion, Kevin supported - approved unanimously.
4. Approval of Scott Kemmer-Slater from Gratiot-Isabella RESD as officer-elect - Jason made the motion, Kevin supported - approved unanimously.
5. [Legislative Update](#) - Matt Schueller, MASA
 - a. Matt is the new Director of Gov't Relations at MASA (as of January 2022).
 - b. Election highlights & summary - Governor Whitmer won by a large margin and there is Democrat majority in state senate - first time since 1983. Will mean some growing pains and adjustments - a lot of behind the scenes staffing and related issues. Democratic margins are very slim - 20-18 Senate, 56-54 House.
 - c. All 3 proposals passed.
 - d. Michigan Democrat priorities could look much different than what we've been used to the last 10 years.
 - e. Lame Duck - likely to be quiet since Dems will take majority in 2023. Discussion about potential ORS return to work change (9 mo to 6 mo).

- f. School safety - several House bills: 6320 (plan updates), 6321 (SRO's), 6324 & 6325 require standardized terminology and standard plan statewide. 6322 requires training for SRO's. No funding for it currently. 6323 creates ISD position for emergency/safety manager. 6326 creates a school safety commission.
 - g. FY 2023 budget highlights and brief discussion.
- 6. MSBO Update
 - a. David Martell provided an update on MSBO current events. Jason Helsen will join the MSBO team in early 2023. Financial Strategies conference in mid-January 2023. Keep eyes open for Amway hotel blocks announcement for MSBO annual conference.
- 7. Roundtable
 - a. Linda B - concerns about flowthrough grants and what impact that will have on indirect rates and similar issues. Paul discussed options and past conversations with Phil Boone at MDE.
 - b. Brian M - local district requested that WISD maintain canvas records of elections. Brian will follow up with the group.
 - c. Chris F - inflation multiplier trending upwards significantly. 7.9% will be used for Headlee millage rollback calculation. Recent discussions with Howard Heideman - reminder that we should send notification to municipality treasurers re: summer taxes.
 - d. Shay A - 31p as federal? Sounds like it - more to come. State codes 234X for State section 31p and 488X for Federal Trails/ARP.
 - e. Linda will chair our December meeting in place of Shay. February meeting - CTE will be covered. Vinson, Kroll, and Church from MDE will join remotely. Please forward questions to Shay.
