- 6. Special Education Maintenance of Effort and Proportionate Share John Andrejack, MDE, Adam Fisher, MDE, and Sean McLaughlin (virtual), MDE
 - John will retire in October or November 2025
 - Michigan is hosting the National Special Ed conference in September 2025
 - MSBO Special Education sub-committee
 - SE4096 personnel reviews John's department is evaluating the costs for Special Education personnel charged to the SE4096. This longer-term project will not be finalized this year. MDE must approve current year reports by January 2025. MARSE and the Allowable Cost Guide must be referenced when adding

- Special Education positions to the SE-4096. Retroactive adjustments will not be made to the SE-4096 based on these personnel reviews. John agreed that we need more clarity in the Allowable Cost Guide, particularly for function 219.
- Excess Costs Everyone should be passing. It is okay to make modifications, just be sure to document the change and why.
- Proportionate share recoding determine set aside for services non-public service plan, not an IEP (required by FAPE). can 'be used for any other purpose.
 Would have to be returned unused. SEA can reallocate unused funds. All or nothing. Documentation around Child Find Activities to demonstrate. To determine if the requirements have been met. If you see that you are not going to be able to spend all the funds, be proactive on recoding.
- MDE OSE Proportionate Share Resources
- Funding resources on the OSE website and in Catamaran
- Maintenance of Effort This should be calculated as the last audit entry! Staff retirements is the most frequently used exception. One time funding and SE formula changes are typical concerns for meeting MOE.

- ARP ESSER final memo amendment window open until November 20
 - Email correspondence from Kevin Walters:

MDE & Final ESSER amendment window open until Nov 20 - I have reviewed dozens of final amendments so far without a single approval based on the fact that people have "NEW" or "ADDED" items in the budget. I thought we made it explicitly clear that no new obligations can

occur during the final amendment period. Only amended amounts, function and object code changes, etc. can occur during this final amendment period. You cannot have any item descriptors associated with "NEW" or "ADDED" items to the budget or it will be denied and sent back for modifications. If you submit a final amendment with an item descriptor that is "NEW" or "ADDED" or anything other than amended, it will be rejected.

As I said, I have literally sent 100% of the reviewed final amendments back for modifications based on the fact that items are listed as "NEW" or "ADDED", etc. MDE cannot approve any new obligations during this final amendment period.
