What happens if you hire someone and they do not meet the requirements? Little would not recommend putting BA degree requirement on our CND cert program. May need to do a walk through of the cert track against the state requirements. Make sure all the content that needs to be there is covered. Lori Atkins, Oakland Schools and Carolyn Thomas, Macomb ISD would be good people to help with this. Many good people have come up through the ranks of the schools to be in a director position who may not have degrees.
