Summary of Financials

Final for 23-24SY Budget (June 2024- Projected Surplus of \$76,590):

 Audited 23-24SY Final – Final Surplus of \$456,462 (largely due to Storrs Donation of \$553,725.49), the difference (\$553,725.49-\$456,462) would have resulted in an actual operating deficit of \$97,263.49

Proposed for 24-25SY Budget (June 2024- Projected Deficit of \$143,287):

\$9800 per pupil for Foundation Allowance w/ est. enrollment of 492.99 students
 (2023-2024 was \$9,608 with 482 students, so this was a projection of \$192 increase per pupil/student to the SA foundation allowance)

Amended for 24-25SY Budget (March 2025- Projected Deficit of \$36,294):

- \$0 increase to Foundation Allowance & enrollment of 484.56 students (loss of 8 students)
- New one-time revenues of the following:
 - \$52,128 147g MPSERS Reimb Grant for 3%
 - \$166,535 147a(4) MPSERS Cost Offset (projected to not receive in 25-26SY)
- Updates in Personnel Expensing to categorize grants where available/allowable. Grants
 must be supplemental in most cases and not supplanting i.e. in addition to what GF
 would provide and not in place of what GF provides.

Final for 24-25SY Budget (June 2025- Projected Surplus of \$109,690):

- Wrap-Up for several grants form previous years with one-time expense and matching revenue required i.e. including 99h, 67f, 61s, 31aa and Section 97.
- Several new grants this year for expenses that would otherwise be General Fund cost
- Reduction of expenses from amendment to final as possible at this point in time

Proposed for 25-26SY Budget (June 2025- Projected Deficit of \$246,488):

- \$10,000 per pupil for Foundation Allowance w/ est. 480 students enrolled (loss of 5)
- Removal of all one-time grant revenues and General Fund pays necessary expenses
- TBD MSP School Resource Officer grant. I am working with the state for getting this grant up to date now and we will recognize revenue/expense in the timeline as required by the auditors.
