MICHIGAN SCHOOL MEAL NUMBERS


6 million more meals served in October 28% increase

On average, 74,000 more students are eating breakfast daily

23% increase

On average, 122,000 more students are eating lunch daily

19% increase



MICHIGAN SCHOOL MEALS PAYMENTS

- State funding is broken down into multiple payments
- 31d lunch and 31f breakfast supplemental payments remain the same
- 30d Michigan School Meals payments are based on these formulas:
 - **30d lunch payment** = [Federal reimbursement for free lunches] minus [Federal reimbursement from reduced price and paid lunch claims **and** 31d lunch payment]
 - **30d breakfast payment** = [Federal reimbursement for free breakfasts] minus [federal reimbursement from reduced-price and paid breakfast claims]

MICHIGAN SCHOOL MEALS CLAIMS AND PAYMENTS

- When should I have my claims submitted?
 - To receive both federal and state payments in the month, claims must be submitted by the $4^{\rm th}$ of the month
- What if I miss the 4th deadline?
 - State aid payments will be processed on the next month's payment
 - Example: November's claim was submitted on December 10th, the state aid payment for the month of November will be included in the January state aid payment
- When do sponsors receive reimbursements and payments?
 - Federal reimbursements will be received as usual
 - Payments for 30d Michigan School Meals, like all other state aid payments, will be made via the State Aid Management System (SAMS) around the 20th of each month

- 3. The year-to-date (YTD) values are current at the time this report is run.
- 4. Additional reconciliations will happen each spring when 31d estimates move to actual, after the calculations are complete with finalized FID School Meals Report data from the previous school year.




PROCUREMENT POLICIES & PROCEDURES


Are Child Nutrition Program Sponsors required to have a Procurement Policy and Procurement Procedures?

- Michigan Legislature Section 380.1274 states that: "The board of a school district or board of directors of a public-school academy shall adopt written policies governing the procurement of supplies, materials, and equipment."
- Title 2, Code of Federal Regulations (2 CFR), Part 200, subpart D, Procurement Standards (2 CFR 200.318(a)) requires all Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) Sponsors to develop and maintain a written code of conduct, and procurement procedures.

POINT OF SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

- Counts are taken daily at the point when the meal is served
- Counts are taken by student eligibility category
- Edit checks
- Backup system for electronic POS
- Adult meals, a la carte items, and second meals are not included in counts that are claimed for reimbursement





Meals are counted at the end of the serving line after the student has had access to all the meal components



SY 22/23 EXCESS FUND BALANCES

- Notifications for Excess Fund Balances (EFB) have been sent out
- Spend Down Plan of Actions Due April 4th
- Training required for Sponsors that are new to having an EFB this year or for new Business Managers or Food Service Directors that did not take the training last year
- EFB must be spent down by June 30, 2024, or request a Carryover Extension

A LA CARTE AND ADULT MEALS REMINDERS

No new negative balances should be occurring after student meal debt was forgiven over the summer

A la Carte and adult meals cannot be charged or offered for free (see USDA FNS SP 20-2016)

Best Practice: address a la Carte items and adult meals in your meal charge policy

Clearly communicate to students, staff, and families



FFVP REMINDERS

- Schools participating in FFVP must widely publicize the program within their schools. Examples include:
 - Posting FFVP menu in cafeteria and/or classrooms
 - Including the fresh fruit or vegetable snack of the day in the morning announcements
 - Parent newsletters
 - Nutrition education signage
 - A FFVP bulletin board in the hallway
 - Sharing the FFVP menu on social media with parents
- FFVP snacks should be offered during the school day, but outside the meal service times. Students cannot take FFVP snack leftovers home.
- Funds should be drawn down MONTHLY, but not until after the snack is served and associated invoices have been paid. Please note, that funds cannot be drawn down in advance.


FY 2025 COORDINATED APPLICATION
