Presentation by Monica Butler, MDE

- Link your MEIS Account and MiLogin accounts now so that when the transition happens you will be prepared.
- Keep an eye on your MEGS plus inbox for additional information as well
- Applications in MEGS+ will stay there, NexSys will only be used for NEW live applications. MEGS+ will eventually go away
- When CMS data "rolls into" NexSys, CMS will no longer exist. (June, 2021)
- Legacy data will stay in MEGS+ so it can be accessed when needed
- Can we upload an Excel spreadsheet (budget) into NexSys? It does have that capability but it will not be in place when it is first implemented.
- The Level 5 user in MEGS+ will need to add users in NexSys although they must be a member of your organization.
- The budget detail that was in MEGS+ will not transfer into NexSys so all items need to be re-typed.

Legislative Update with Michael Latvis, Wayne RESA

- Starting April 2nd all student athletes ages 13-19 must be tested before practices and games. MDHHS will come out with more guidance tomorrow.
- Plan to see a new budget recommendation from the Governor that reflects all of the federal funding we are receiving.

- Discussion with Treasury re: hazard pay
- ORS independent contractor audit, consider requesting an extension, legal firms are working on this
