3. Perform and document required pre-trip and post-trip vehicle inspections
4. Attend meetings, programs and in-service training as assigned
5. Perform other related duties as assigned
6. Must be physically, mentally and emotionally qualified to operate a school bus and evacuate children from a school bus in the event of an emergency
7. Sufficient strength and agility; lift the hood to inspect the engine compartment, clean the windshield and carry ill or physically impaired children
