- 3. Dwan gave us a great overview of the money that will be distributed to districts and the requirements of districts to receive that money. Pay attention to this link on ESSER <u>Federal Funds MSBO</u>
- 4. Drake Device purchasing bids are open. The statewide advisory is meeting March 24 to do hands-on device evaluation to go to the board.

Final approval in April. The actual purchase open will be April 14, 2021 thru April 30, 2021.

Software bids were awarded March 9 and will open next week to include Microsoft, Adobe, and Discovery, internet content filtering. You will have your pricing before July 1. - At this point we are in the same requirement as we were last year.
- Be ready to have all equipment updated and ready to go for next month testing.
- Testing with personal devices? It will work but not recommended unless you have done that in the past.
- We may not be able to enforce the 95% students need to be tested.

  - Funding Year 20 and 21 Updates and Quick Reminders
  - State Educational Network Procurement Update
  - Federal Legislation Supporting Connectivity and E-Rate
  - State Level Broadband Action Updates
  - FY 2020 Update- 98.6% of FRNs have received FCDLs
    - Only 28 to go!
  - FY 2021 Update- 860 Total funding requests seeking \$12,762,318.38
    - USAC: 80% of Form 471s submitted are for Category One service/transport (nationally)
  - Reminders
    - Gift Rule waiver through end of FY 2020 (6/30/21)
    - FCC Order on automatic extensions for FRNs receiving an RFCDL
    - Don't use banned providers (Huawei or ZTE)
  - State Educational Network Procurement Update
    - Transport and IA RFP received bids, reviewed, and has a solution for SEN 2.0 and IA
      - Details to follow soon, but enhancements and changes off of this procurement will not be fully in place until July, 2022
  - Federal Legislation Supporting Connectivity
    - American Rescue Plan Act includes \$7.1 billion for E-Rate
      - FCC will have to decide what the program looks like an is likely to request comment before the program is crafted
      - High level: discounts on purchases of vendor equipment and services to serve students off campus
        - District and ISD WANs are NOT an option to serve students in the home (my reading)
    - Emergency Broadband Benefit
      - Schools are NOT eligible for the EBB subsidy (my reading)
      - Schools (or ISD or MDE) will likely need to verify NSLP or other poverty indicators to a family to receive the EBB subsidy (FERPA fears)
    - Remote Learning Petition
      - FCC still constructing a program after comments from the field
        - MDE did comment asking for cost-allocation of off-campus use to be waived completely and forever (supporting SECA comments)
    - State-level Broadband Work
    - Connecting MI Communities Grant and
      - CMIC funding for Round 1.5 and Round 2 should be announced in the coming months
    - Connecting MI Task Force

- Listening Tour completed, comments are compiled and we will meet to discuss next steps
- MiConnect (METL and MAISA)
  - \$300k from Mott Foundation for statewide data collection on connectivity to the home
  - Working with partners to avoid duplication of data collection efforts before commencing the collection
- Justification to Re-Start the State Matching Fund grant for self-provisioned fiber builds
