** Schools must administer the PSAT 8/9 for grade 9 and PSAT 10 on April 13-19, 2022 (unless students are approved with accommodations that designate them to test in the accommodated testing window).

- Schools can choose which date works best for them as the initial test day.
- The same grade must test on the same day at the same time.


WIDA Testing

- ❑ Testing ends March 25, 2022
- ❑ As of today, 82% of expected test sessions have been completed and 140 schools have **not** started testing
- ❑ Intermittent testing problems occurred during 1st week of testing
 - ❑ Not a capacity issue
 - ❑ Missing content files in Central Office Services (COS-SD)
 - ❑ Intermittent application services responsiveness
 - ❑ Impacted student experience but no student responses were lost
 - ❑ Long wait times with DRC call center
