

## Section 105/105c Schools of Choice Summary

<b>Public Notice No Later than 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday in August</b> <b>(Friday, August 12, 2022)</b>	<b>Public Notice Date Not Specified</b>
Provide public notice of limited available slots; identify dates of application period ( <b>must be at least 15 calendar days but not more than 30 calendar days</b> ), and must identify the place and manner for submitting the application.	Provide public notice of unlimited available slots; identify dates of application period ( <b>must be at least 15 days - no maximum number of days specified for unlimited window</b> ). Notice must identify the place and manner for submitting the application.

<b>Within 15 Days After Application Period Closes</b> <b>(Based on Published Application Window Dates)</b>	<b>No Date Specified for Offer of SOC Enrollment, But Enrollment Must Be Complete By End of First Week of School</b> <b>(Based on District SY Start Date)</b>
Determine applicants to be offered enrollment (see next two bullets for detail), notify parents; identify the date by which the pupil must complete enrollment process <b>(which must be no later than the end of first week of school)</b>	Offer enrollment to all eligible applicants (pupils ineligible are those: suspended w/in the last 2 years by another district, ever expelled, or ever convicted of a felony); notify parents; identify date by which pupil must complete enrollment process <b>(which must be no later than end of first week of school)</b>
❖If number of applicants is less than available slots – all eligible applicants are offered enrollment, and no waiting list is required.	
❖If the number of applicants exceeds available slots, district must give preference to applicants residing in the same household as pupils currently enrolled under Section 105c; and remaining slots are filled by random draw. Random draw should continue until all applications are exhausted, as the random draw is also used to establish a required numbered waiting list.	
<b>Numbered Waiting List</b> <b>Beginning 3rd Monday in August to End of First Week of School</b> <b>(Monday, August 15, 2022 – Based on District SY Start)</b>	<b>No Waiting List – Unlimited Slots</b>
Slots still available, due to non-enrollment of selected applicants or added slots, may be offered to numbered waiting list pupils, in order. Once the waiting list is exhausted, remaining slots <u>may not</u> be filled until 2 <sup>nd</sup> term (if the district has an optional 2 <sup>nd</sup> term window).	
<b><u>Optional 2<sup>nd</sup> Term Window (if district elects to participate)</u> Public Notice of Second Term Window</b> <b>No Later than 2 Weeks Prior to End of 1<sup>st</sup> Term</b>	<b><u>Optional 2<sup>nd</sup> Term Window (if district elects to participate)</u> Public Notice of Second Term Window (Optional)</b> <b>No Later than 2 Weeks Prior to End of 1<sup>st</sup> Term</b>
Provide public notice of limited slots and identify dates of application period ( <b>2<sup>nd</sup> term application period must be the last 2 weeks of the first term</b> ), and place/manner for applying.	Provide public notice of unlimited slots and identify dates of application period ( <b>2<sup>nd</sup> term application period must be the last 2 weeks of the first term</b> ), and place/manner for applying.
All applications must be received during the published window.	All applications must be received during the published window.
<b>By Start of 2<sup>nd</sup> Term</b>	<b>By Start of 2<sup>nd</sup> Term</b>
Determine applicants to be offered enrollment (first applying preference to applicants in same household as pupil already enrolled under 105/105c, then by random draw, if applicants exceed available slots), notify parents; identify the date by which the pupils must be enrolled ( <b>enrollment must be complete no later than end of first week of the 2<sup>nd</sup> term</b> ).	Offer enrollment to all eligible applicants (pupils ineligible are those: suspended w/in the last 2 years, ever expelled, or ever convicted of a felony); notify parents; identify the date by which pupil must complete enrollment process ( <b>enrollment must be complete no later than end of first week of 2<sup>nd</sup> term</b> ).

**\*NOTE: Under 105c, to enroll a special education pupil, the choice district must have a signed special education cost agreement with the pupil's resident district outlining how the costs of the pupil's special education will be covered, and how the agreement will be modified if those costs change**
